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




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

EXECUTIVE ABSTRACT - THE FUTURE IS ALREADY HERE!

We launched the 5th edition of the Energy Strategy Summit - "Mapping the Future!" - having in mind the implicit metaphor of a navigator discovering distant territories, with few clues but a bold vision, risking its own resources to replace the white spots in the knowledge of the world with information essential for us all. We strived to bring together such navigators, and intended to overlap their inevitably fragmentary and particular perspectives in order to draw a map of the future for the Romanian energy industry.

On June 11, once the last speeches were delivered, once the final conclusions were drawn, we found that the right metaphor is different - the puzzle game. The central idea is that the future is already here (Mihai Bălan, RWEA); almost all the elements we need to meet the challenges of tomorrow are already available. Technological solutions exist, produced by major global companies, a few clicks and only a few days away for competent integrators (Cristian Pîrvulescu, Enevo Grup). In many places, managers and their teams implement business sustainability strategies that take into account local realities and do not depend essentially on the structure or the origin of the shareholders (Ondrej Safar, CEZ România).

Strong guidelines

The outlines of the image to result once the puzzle has been completed are also known. Some are specific to the national energy industry as the benefits of a balanced mix of primary energy resources must be maintained (Elena Popescu, the Minister of Energy). Others are related to Romania's membership of the European Union: besides the interconnection and free markets, decarbonization is a tendency we cannot ignore; coal will have a slow-paced assisted dying (Adrian Şuta, Transelectrica), and the generation of energy based on renewable resources will increase, with less and less financial support from outside the market. Another category of tendencies influencing the design of the puzzle brings together a large cluster of sub-trends such as cloud computing, cyber security (Victor Gânsac, Safetech Innovations, talked about it), industry 4.0 etc. Digital transformation strengthens the role of consumers - through distributed generation (prosumers), demand-response and energy efficiency - and brings more flexibility, dynamism and relevance into the energy value chain. Adopting them is a continuous and incremental process by which companies' operational and financial performance are improved (Mihai Dârzan, Ringhel). For critical companies, the adoption of innovation must, however, be weighted by the risk that new technologies or computer systems can introduce (Mircea Modran, Electrica SA).

Missing parts

We still have no useful definition of vulnerable consumer (Anca Dragu, E.On România), but we now have a clear understanding of the need for this mechanism, as well as a concrete proposal on how it might work (Franck Neel, FPPG). We need to update the legal framework so that financial instruments already tested elsewhere to be put to work also in Romania. Contracts for difference are an example and could be operational by the end of the year (Anton Anton, the Minister of Energy); the new National Investment Plan is another. Amending Law 123 could remove some of the barriers identified in concluding bilateral agreements - PPA (Martin Moise, PATRES), and by adopting the district heating law, the conditions for new investments in the cogeneration sector could also be created. After all, any new project depends on the extent to which the anticipated return on investment exceeds the profit opportunities that other types of placements allow in other jurisdictions (Saniya Melnicenco, ROPEPCA) or even locally, in other markets (Cosmin Ghiţă, Nuclearelectrica). The banking sector is expecting major projects to support (Ramona Kurko, BCR), and a list of such projects in under construction, even if currently almost exclusively in the cogeneration area (Petre Stroe, MET România Energy; Constantin Văduva, SAPE SA, Argentina Tătaru, Romgaz).

There is a need for a new round of concession for new oil perimeters and this should be launched very soon (Florin Radu Ciocănelea, Romanian Government), but the success in attracting new investments is largely due to the general functioning framework of the O&G market, from access to technical and geological data, the reduced bureaucracy, the stability of legislation and more liquidity in centralized markets (Saniya Mendicancy, ROPEPCA). To the achievement of the latter will contribute both to the interconnection of natural gas networks as well as new volumes of onshore and offshore products. In addition, the natural gas storage capacity has to be increased (Dumitru Chiriță, ANRE). The largest natural gas producer in Romania, also the main storage capacity operator is ready for this (Argentina Tatar, Romgaz) even if the plans for the next years are far from the additional 3 billion cubic meters identified by the authorities. Compliance with investment plans (especially by Transgaz and Transelectrica is essential, and the example in the hydro sector can be a model, at least through the announced projects for the next years (Marian Bratu, Hidroelectrica).

The future depends on the new generations, who are heading the new technologies and trends. Trends are digitization and decarbonisation, but at the same time, beyond innovation, we should gather all our resources to innovate in these directions (Carmen Neagu, EnergoBit). Sustainable funding has passed from the concept phase to a large phenomenon, with hundreds of billions of euros allotted over the past year alone (Oana Mogoi, ING Bank).

The crucial element - a real and honest dialogue

In order for the recommendations from each sector to be used in shaping national strategies, there is a need for extra generosity on behalf of all stakeholders. We already have robust analyzes by credible consultants (among them Deloitte, EPG, Emerton, PwC, KPMG, Nera Economic Consulting and CMS etc.) for the renewable and oil and gas sectors, for the nuclear and coal sectors. The authorities demand that such analyzes take into account the national electro-energetic system as a whole (Elena Popescu, Ministry of Energy), and in some cases this is already happening (Mihai Balan, RWEA).

However, it all depends on the recovery of trust, seriously undermined by the sudden changes in legislation and regulation in recent years - the withdrawal of support for renewable energies (from 2013), how the offshore law and GEO 114 were adopted (2018) are just the most visible examples. Part of this exercise of transparency and trust is respecting the principles of corporate governance (Johan Meyer, Fondul Proprietatea); another element is participation in public consultations the good faith and extra ambition from the side of big state owned companies (Florin Radu Ciocănelea, Romanian Government).

Not vision is what we miss, but the light hearted engineer's persistence

At the 2019 Energy Strategy Summit, the authorities and the private sector met, in almost the same words, under the idea that Romania is blessed with abundant and varied natural resources (Anton Anton, Ministry of Energy, Johan Meyer, Fondul Proprietatea). Romania is well positioned to ensure the sustainability and independence of production, distribution and supply of energy for its own needs and it has the potential to develop these resources to become a key player on the European market. We also have the advantage of being able to put together a firm foundation of tradition with the opening to new technologies, the experience of seniors with the enthusiasm of young people.

Not the bold vision of a Christopher Columbus is what we need and also the benevolent encouragement of a new Queen Isabella would not help too much to bring us closer to an intangible future; what we need is the tonic meticulosity of the engineer who, side by side with the technologist, understands the overall picture and patiently places in their places all the pieces – cutting, lathing or welding them when needed, in order to obtain a functional mechanism.
